The **International Observatory on Participatory Democracy (OIDP)** is a network of over 500 of the world's towns and cities, associations, organisations and research centres interested in learning about, exchanging impressions and applying participatory democracy experiences at a local scale, for the purpose of extending democratic practices in municipal governments.

10 YEARS OF EXPERIENCES

The network was created in 2001 within the framework of the Decentralised Cooperation Projects of the European Union's URB-AL Programme. Since 2006 the OIDP has been working in collaboration with the **World Organisation of United Cities and Local Governments**, at the present time contributing to the provision of innovative knowledge at the service of local government in the field of participatory democracy. The OIDP Technical Secretariat is currently under the auspices of the **Barcelona City Council**, a widely acknowledged international reference in terms of the exchange of participatory democracy experiences aimed at promoting cooperation between local governments throughout the world.

The OIDP is a worldwide centre of reference for the **production of knowledge** (the R&D of Participatory Democracy).

The OIDP is consolidated as a space for the exchange of useful experiences.

The OIDP contributes, through all of this production, to the enrichment of the public policies of municipal governments.



A NETWORK OF 547 TOWNS AND CITIES IN 52 COUNTRIES






INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE


DIVERSIFICATION AND DECENTRALIZATION

Diversifying the composition of the network's members in order to reach out to all of the regions in the world, decentralising the structure.




DISTINCTION

Establishing **synergies** with other international organisations and the academic world.




LOCAL SPHERE
