#### **WORKPLACE**

The gender parity has reached its **lowest level** since 2006 (WEF, 2022)



#### **LEADERSHIP**

Leadership positions held by women **increased only 1% since 2015** (UN, 2023)



#### **PARLIAMENTS**

Women are **only 24**% of the seats in national parliaments (UNDP, 2023)
