<b>Summary and methodology</b>	<p>Methodology: Lecture with time for questions.</p> <p>We give examples of participatory initiatives in Sweden and the special prerequisites that participation faces in a Nordic welfare model. It focuses on the three fields of participation processes that are most up-and-coming among local authorities in Sweden over the last few years:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. A dialogue in complex and conflictive issues, with the example of the city of Gothenburg which has carried out a process called “life without violence” over a one year period in a deprived area of the city.</li> <li>2. Participatory budgeting in Sweden has gradually evolved from small projects to now at least one or two larger PB’s!</li> <li>3. The relationship between the local authority and the organized civil society takes many forms and shapes. Over the lasst years there have been a shift towardds more collaboration.</li> </ol>
