

## Summary of the adopted agreements

<u>1st AGREEMENT</u>: regional offices are led by local governments, but participation of civil society organizations is sought.

<u>2nd AGREEMENT</u>: in order to establish new regional offices, processes of dialogue will be implemented on regional or state level and a formal candidacy will be addressed to the General Secretary with the support of at least the simple majority from the members in a State or region. The simple majority of the members will be established according to the number of active members in a country or region, by the technical secretary.

<u>3rd AGREEMENT</u>: to officialise a new promoting member, a formal letter from the mayor will be addressed to the General Secretary.

4th AGREEMENT: The presidency is made up of two co-presidents: the political person in charge of the city that organizes the conference the current year and the political person in charge of the city that organized the conference the previous year...

<u>5th AGREEMENT</u>: the city of Cocody, Ivory Coast, will organize the IOPD Conference in 2020 and will assume the presidency of the network.

<u>6th AGREEMENT</u>: the city of Grenoble, France, will organize the IOPD Conference in 2022 and will assume the presidency of the network.

7th AGREEMENT: adoption of the final declaration of the 19th IOPD Conference

<u>8th AGREEMENT</u>: the two work thematic priorities for the technical secretariat are "citizen participation and climate change" and "gender and citizen participation".
