The Cocody 2020 Declaration, drafted in a participatory and consensual manner during the IOPD General Assembly, will be adopted and read at the closing ceremony.

The Cocody 2020 Declaration of expresses a commitment of Local Governments to defend, strengthen and promote participatory democracy as a strategic axis in the Sustainable Development processes of Municipalities and Regions.

## **Expected results**

The participants will have to draft, in a consensual and participatory manner, a final declaration, known as the "Cocody 2020 Declaration", which will be approved during the IOPD General Assembly and read at the closing session. This declaration will be a strong commitment of Local Governments to defend, strengthen and promote participatory democracy as strategic axes in the Sustainable Development processes of Municipalities and Regions.

The Cocody 2020 conference is expecting the participation of about 300 people, including natural or legal persons, from countries all over the world, interested in the practice and improvement of participatory democracy at the local level, representatives of Governments and Legislative Assemblies, Mayors, Presidents of Regions and Districts, Officials of autonomous organizations, Officials and members of international organizations and municipal networks, Activists and people involved in social movements, members of civil society organizations and the private sector, Researchers and members of research centers from different countries and geographical areas.


