The Scotland PB Journey

Community Empowerment Act (Scotland) 2015

Agreement between Scottish Government and COSLA (The Convention of Local Authorities)

At least 1% of local government budgets will be subject to PB by 2022

All of Scotland's 32 Local Authorities committed

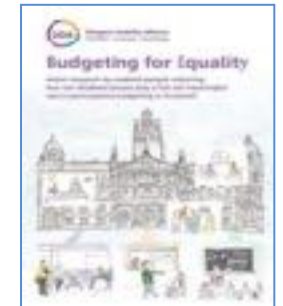

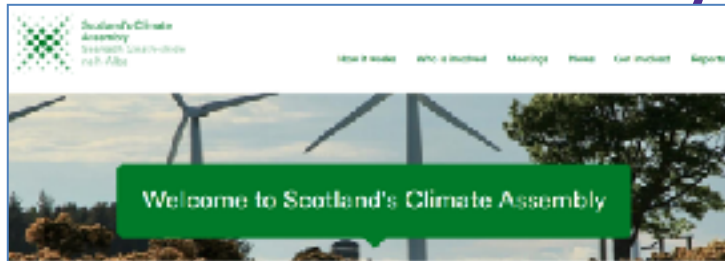
